As a reminder, all cattle must have an official health certificate issued within 30 days of the sale and must include a 15-digit EID number for each consignment. EID tags can be ordered through an animal health supplier by providing your farm's premise ID number.

Entries

- **Deadline: September 9, 2022**. Preference is given to earlier entries; late entries may not be accepted.
- Fee: \$50 per head, non-refundable. Entry fees are payable to Ohio Shorthorn Breeders' Association (OSBA). Mail to: Beth Carper 6371 Giehl Rd. Delaware, OH 43015
- Entries will not be accepted without the entry fee. No exceptions. Emailed entries are acceptable when followed by payment before September 9, 2022. Email entries to: osbafallshowcasesale@gmail.com

Registration Certificates

- All entries must be registered with the American Shorthorn Association.
- ASA registration certificates MUST ACCOMPANY payment unless registration is pending. IF registration is pending, pedigree info must be completed on the entry form.

Rules & Guidelines

- Genetic Defect Testing: Animals that are potential carriers of known genetic defects should be tested prior to entry, but it is not required. Animals found to be carriers of genetic defects will still be permitted to sell.
- Cattle can arrive Friday, October 21, 2022, and all cattle must be in place Saturday, October 22, 2022 by 5 p.m.
- All cattle must have an official health certificate on or after September 23, 2022, and must include 15-digit ID number for each consignment.
- The sale order will be determined by the sale committee. Cattle will be evaluated during check-in and immediately afterwards in the stalls.
- All consignors must be members of the Ohio Shorthorn Breeders' Association. Dues will be deducted from sale proceeds if consignors are not members of the organization.
- All sales, including "no sales/buybacks" will be charged full commission and full sales expenses.
- All animals must be tagged with an EID tag. (EID tags can be ordered through an animal health supplier or through your local veterinarian by providing your farm's premise ID number. Premise ID numbers can be obtained by filling out an application at www.agri.ohio.gov/divs/animalid.asp
- All cattle should be in good health. Any cattle deemed to be ill or a potential detriment to healthy cattle will be asked to leave the sale facility by request of the Sale Committee.
