President Jeff Winkle called the annual meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Jeff Winkle led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Officer Reports

- November 8, 2021 & January 19, 2022 Meeting Minutes - Trudi Tilton distributed printed copies of both the November board meeting and the January board conference call meeting. Members independently read both minutes. No corrects or additions were made. Jeff Barr moved to accept both meeting minutes as presented. Dave Greenhorn seconded. Motion passed by voice vote.
- Treasurer’s Report – Renae Logsdon distributed paper copy of a succinct financial report to the membership present.
 - Account balances are as follows: OSBA checking - \$10,167.32, OJSA - \$8,388.35, endowment fund - \$6,679.19, and OSBA savings - \$8,548.23.
 - Jeff Barr moved to accept the Treasurer’s Report. John Schillinger seconded. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

OJSA Report – presented by OJSA Board (Brandon Barr, Macy Burchett, Caroline Tilton, & Caroline Winter)

- Shared that Ohio won Outstanding Junior Association recognition at NJSS 2021 in Louisville, KY
- NJSS will be held in Kansas City, MO June 19-25, 2022. Theme is “Out of this World”
- Preview Show 2022 held with Maine and Chi Juniors. Date & location not yet confirmed. Theme – “Shoot for the Stars.”
- Annual silent auction at Ohio Beef Expo. Asked for support both through donations of items to

include in auction and for bids during the auction.

- There is currently one opening on board that needs to be filled.

Lassies Report – presented by LaDonna Workman, Ohio Lassies Treasurer

- Will be providing coffee and breakfast snacks in sale barn at Expo Friday & Saturday mornings.
- Since last year's display honoring Keith Moore at Lassie booth in sale barn at Expo was so well received, the Lassies are looking to create another picture display for 2022. This time the focus will be history of breed and all breeders in Ohio. Anyone who has pictures to include in display, please send to Karen Bihl. Items will be returned.
- Royalty for 2022 – Princesses Anna Kosman & Sawyer Hayslip.
- Desirae Logsdon is serving as Vice President on the National Lassies Board.
 - Sierra Betts, National Alternate Lassies Queen, shared highlights of her current reign
 - She's grateful to be able to serve in this capacity.
 - She was crowned at NJSS in June 2021.
 - Since then, she's attended many shows, meetings, and sales representing the breed.
 - She's traveled 8,076 miles proudly wearing The Plaid.
 - Alyssa Betts, Ohio Shorthorn Lassie Queen, addressed the assembly.
 - She's enjoyed serving in her position.
 - She's represented Ohio at many state and national Shorthorn events during her reign.
 - She will not be running for National Queen because she'll be focusing on her college education.

ASA Report – presented by Dave Greenhorn

- Cattlemen's Congress very successful. Debate over Cattlemen's Congress or National Western continues.
- Deck the Stalls at NAILE was extremely successful and puts AJSA in strong financial standings.

OCA Report – presented by Elizabeth Harsh, Executive Director of OCA

- Shared various current agricultural stats & legislation
- Ohio Beef Expo will be back to normal for 2022
- Tradeshow is sold out
- There is an OCA recruitment incentive in place.

- Ohio Beef Expo – Jeff Winkle
 - Judge at show – Gene Steiner
 - 1 sale ring
 - Shorthorns offering 36 live lots (12 PB females, 11 plus females, 9 PB bulls, & 4 plus bulls), 8 semen lots, & 2 embryo lots
 - Online catalog went up today
 - Lunch will be served after show in sale barn
 - Jeff complimented the display the Lassies put together in 2021
 - Booth again in tradeshow
 - Welcomed volunteers to cover booth
 - The Beast blower will be the raffle for 2022. Proceeds will go to OJSA. Share the Vision Sale donated the blower.

- Presence at last year's tradeshow increased OSBA membership. 165 members in 2021.
- Ohio State Fair – Renae Logsdon
 - Normal fair 2022
 - Show and stalling will remain as they were in 2021; show in Cooper & stall in viaducts
 - Shorthorns in 2nd rotation
 - Out of state cattle will be permitted in 2022.
 - Purebred numbers are strong enough that they will show as a breed. Plus numbers are borderline. Plus will show as a breed in 2022, but if numbers don't increase will be moved to AOB in 2023. Alternative is that OSBA covers cost (\$2000).
- Farm Science Review – Tom Turner
 - The lot is reserved for 2022.
 - Weather was an obstacle in 2021. Review closed on Wednesday due to weather.
 - Purpose of being at FSR is to put Shorthorn cattle in front of more people.
 - Ohio has more registered Shorthorn cattle than any other state.

 - July 9, 2022 at Holmes County Fairgrounds
 - Cattle can arrive July 8 after 3:00 PM
 - Open to all breeds
 - Order of show – Jr. Showmanship > Junior Show > break > Open Show
- Fall Showcase Sale – Kendall Shonkwiler
 - October 23, 2022 at Paint Valley Farm
 - Kevin Wendt, auctioneer

 - Social Media – traffic down
